

**Change the affirmative example into negative and interrogative:**

<b>CONDITIONAL TENSE</b>		
<b>Use</b>	<b>It is used in conditional sentences and as a past equivalent of the future simple.</b>	
<b>Aff.</b>	<b>S + would (= 'd) + V (inf.) + Cs.</b>	
	<b>- I'd like to visit New York.</b>	
<b>Neg.</b>	<b>S + would + not (= wouldn't) + V (inf.) + Cs.</b>	
	<b>-</b>	
<b>Int.</b>	<b>Would (= 'd) + S + V (inf.) + Cs?</b>	
	<b>-</b>	
<b>Short Answers</b>	<b>Yes, + S + would.</b>	<b>No, + S + would + not.</b>
